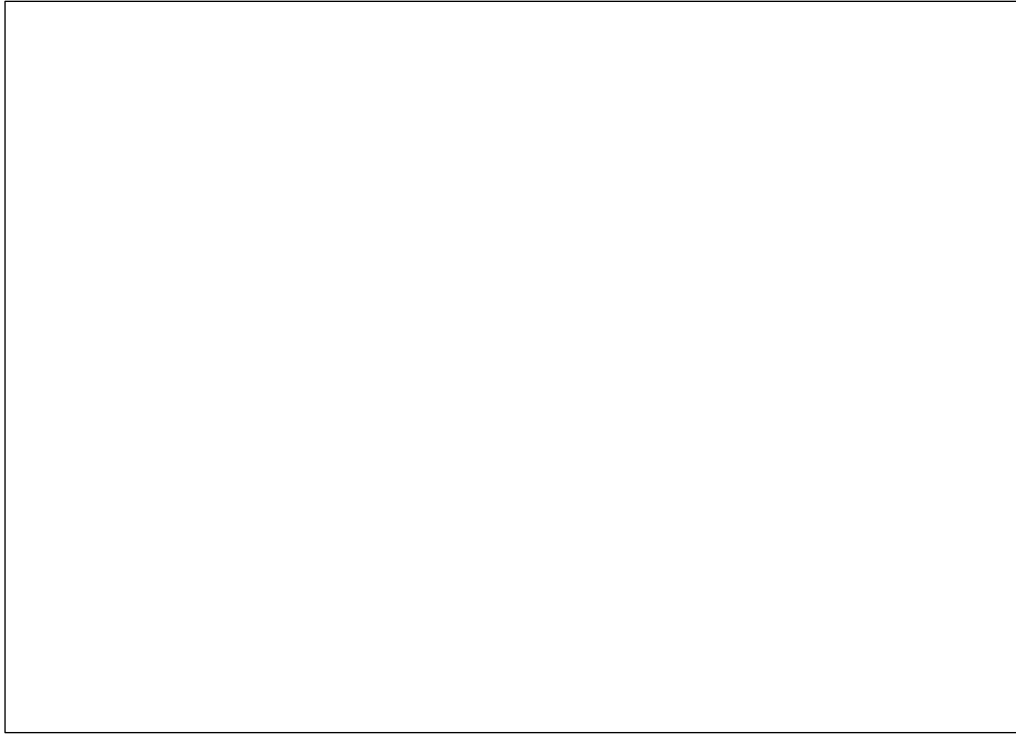
Key Reminders

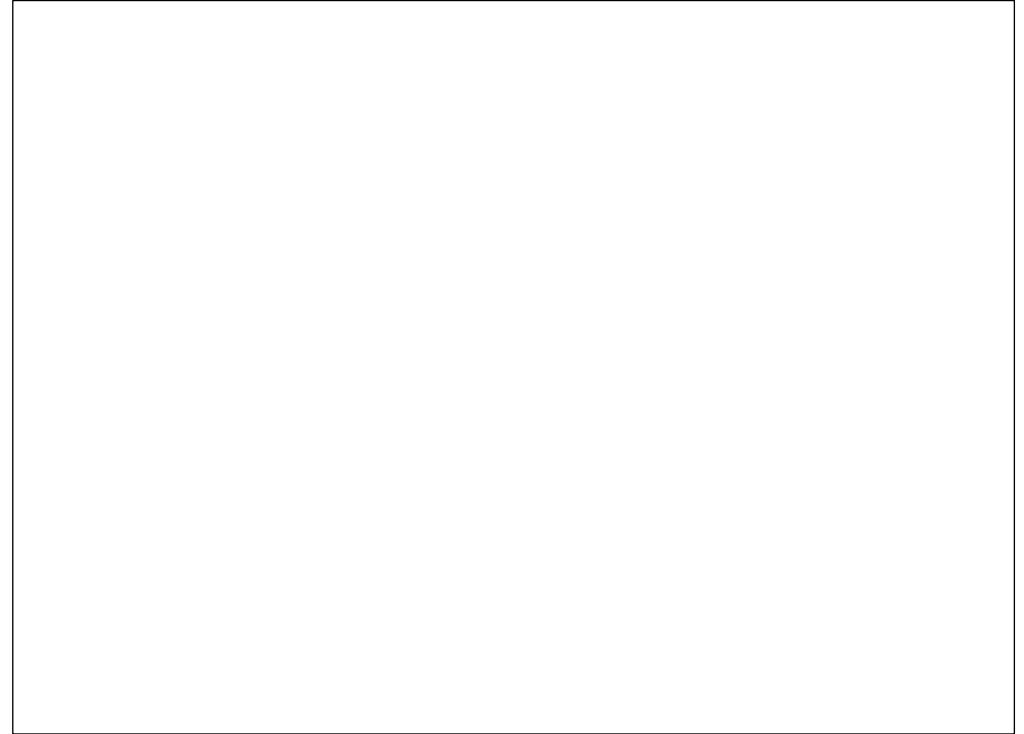
