



Special Instrumental Scholarship

In 2019, Nagle Catholic College established the Year 7 Special Instrumental Scholarship Program, with 25 scholarships on offer. The Special Instrumental Scholarship is offered to students who show potential for learning and excelling on a chosen musical instrument. All Year 7 students will be given the opportunity to take a musical aptitude prior to commencing at the College. If selected, students are given the option to learn a band instrument or voice for free through the program.

The choice of instruments is as follows:

WOODWINDS

Flute
Clarinet
Saxophone

BRASS

Trumpet
Trombone
Euphonium

OTHER

Voice
Percussion

The package provided as part of the programme includes the following:

- 1 x 25 minute group lesson per week for the 2019 school year;
- 1 x 50 minutes band rehearsal per week (Thursday 8.00-8.50am);
- 1 x 50 minutes choir rehearsal per week (Wednesday 8.00-8.50am);
- A minimal hire fee (\$50 per semester); and
- Performance opportunities throughout the year.

Students who are accepted into this program will be required to:

- Fully commit to the program for a minimum of one year;
- Regularly attend the weekly band and choir rehearsals;
- Fulfil practice requirements;
- Prepare for each lesson; and
- Purchase a performance shirt (\$20);

Students who show musical aptitude will be invited to apply for their choice of instrument.
