

YEAR 8 EXTRA REQUIREMENTS – 2018

THE ITEMS LISTED BELOW, OTHER THAN THE SCHOOL DIARY CAN BE PURCHASED IN YOUR LOCAL AREA.

CALCULATORS

All Mathematics students in Year 8 require a Scientific Calculator. Please see attached order details from Abacus Calculators.

LOCKERS

New Lockers will be issued at the end of 2017 for 2018. Students are required to take their lock home with them over the summer break. Students should have kept their combination locks from Year 7. Students will use their combination locks until Year 12. ***A charge will be applied for lost or damaged locks and debited to school fees. Please see Mrs Fariss immediately if this is the case.***

CREATIVE DANCE STUDENTS

All Year 8 Creative Dance students are required to purchase **plain black** knee/or ¾ length leggings (no colour).

ENGLISH

A subscription to *Literacy Planet* is provided to all students.

HOME ECONOMICS – FOOD

All Home Economics students require an Apron and Bandanna from the Home Economics department. Students should have retained their apron and bandanna from Year 7. If a new one is required pay \$15.50 to the front office and show receipt to the teacher (\$5 for bandanna and \$10.50 for apron) and it will be issued to the student. Students are expected to bring their own devices, pens, highlighters and glue sticks to class.

INSTRUMENTAL STUDENTS

- **Guitar** ~ Students will require a guitar pick.
- **Drums** ~ Students will require a pair of drumsticks.

PENS AND PENCILS

Students are to supply pens, sharpeners, pencils, rulers, erasers, coloured pencils, highlighters, textas, glue sticks, scissors and pencil cases as required.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Digital resources are provided for all students.

SCHOOL DIARY

Each student receives a College Homework Diary at the beginning of the year. The cost of the Diary is debited to the family fees account. Replacement diaries are available for purchase from the school office.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

It is recommended that all articles of school clothing including shoes, be clearly marked with the student's name. Please ensure that names are not visible to the eye on items such as hats (writing to be on inside on hat and not on the brim at all).

SCIENCE ~ ALL SUBJECTS

A digital science resource is provided for all students.

STUDENT ICT INFORMATION

Nagle Catholic College operates a Bring Your Own Device program across 7 to 12.

The College recommends a Windows based 2-in-1 laptop/tablet or similar for students. iPads are not preferred due to reduced functionality, but can be used if already purchased/supplied. Students who have existing working iPads may continue to use them. Students joining the College in 2018 or students who have reached a point of upgrading their device, should consider the preferred option of the 2-in-1 Windows device.

SOFTWARE AND FUNCTIONALITY

For 2018, all students will be provided with new login details allowing them to then download Office for Students, for free. Students have access to many features via the College Office 365 subscription. This includes:

- College emails
- Online file storage
- Online versions of Microsoft Office to edit work
- Free downloads of Microsoft Office for students

Students will be provided with instructions to download and install Office on their device in 2018.

All student devices should be compatible with Microsoft Office. Generally, students should be able to perform the following functions on their device:

- Word processing – Microsoft Word
- Basic image editing
- Basic filming and editing of short movies
- Spreadsheets – Microsoft Excel
- Viewing PDF documents
- Creating and viewing presentations – Microsoft PowerPoint
- Online research
- Use of online learning tools

Students may like to consider any specialist software they may use in any specialist subjects (e.g. Design) and may seek to have the same or comparable software available for completion of work at home.

Computers are available around the College for student use of speciality software such as the Adobe Creative Suite and AutoCAD.

SEQTA Learn

Teaching materials and other learning resources are available to students via SEQTA Learn. Students should take responsibility for viewing any missed lessons in SEQTA Learn and downloading the revision materials.

STORAGE & ACCESSORIES

All students are provided with a Microsoft account which allows 1TB of online storage via 'OneDrive'.

All students should have headphones available for use in classes.
