

Key Indicators Year 12 2022 Results

The staff of Nagle Catholic College strives earnestly to assist students to achieve their best possible academic results. As part of the Reflective Practice process, an analysis of Year 12 results is conducted every year and forms the basis of any change to teaching practices from Years 7-12. Students at Nagle follow one of two pathways. Pathway 1- General studies leading to engagement in the workforce or further study in a variety of formats. Pathway 2- ATAR studies enabling students to obtain an Australian Tertiary Admissions Ranking (ATAR) for entrance to university.

The School Curriculum and Standards Authority, the Tertiary Information Services Centre and Catholic Education Western Australia make a wide range of data and statistics available. Nagle Catholic College also collates its own data.

The following sets of data are those considered to be the most useful in providing feedback to the College community.

Achievement of WACE

The achievement of the West Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) is an important base level of achievement for all students. It is also a requirement for entry into university.
